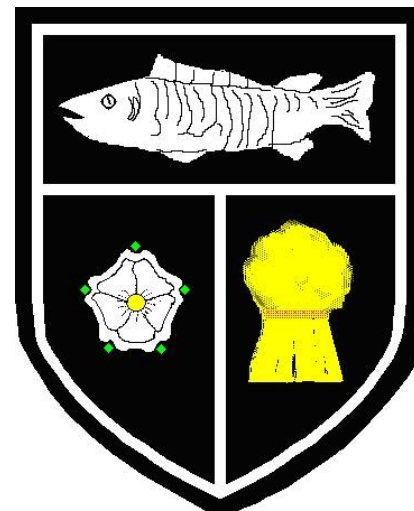
- Provide a high quality education in a caring and supportive environment that will encourage a love of life-long learning;

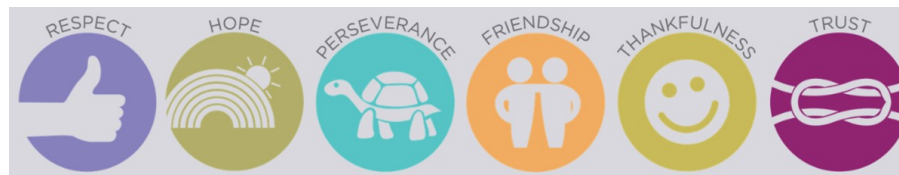
