The International Centre for Arts and Narrative (iCAN), an innovative and academic partnership between York St John and York Theatre Royal have offered school free arts workshops that allow KS2 to explore and understand the concept of narrative and how they might use it to communicate their own ideas. The worshops will take place in the De Grey rooms next to the theatre.

The children will be encouraged to create something, which could be anything, ranging from a poem to visual art or a piece of theatre or music.

Class 3 will take part in their workshop on Thursday 5th March.

Class 4 will take part in their workshop on Thursday 19th March.

The workshop will take place within school hours. Children will need to bring a packed lunch to eat and plenty to drink during the day. (No fizzy drinks or glass bottles please.)

As the workshops are free, the only cost of the visit will be the coach. We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £4 per child to go towards covering the cost. Unfortunately if we do not receive enough voluntary contributions the trip may not be able to go ahead.
