Elvington CE Primary School uses the National Primary Curriculum (2014) to deliver the programmes of study. It is taught in termly blocks on a rolling 2 year cycle in Key Stage One and a four year rolling cycle in Key Stage Two. Children in the Foundation Stage follow the topics in Key Stage One, but their learning is adapted for the EYFS Framework 2014.


The school follows the National Curriculum to deliver maths and English, making use of cross curricular links where appropriate based upon the topic being taught during the term.
