Our topic this term is... BURIED TREASURE!

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
This topic will incorporate lots of history as we will study the Ancient Egyptians. We will focus on a range of questions:

 - Where can the most important Ancient Egypt sites be found?
 - How do we know about life from this time period?
 - What are Egyptologists?
 - Why are there differing interpretations of the past?

In science the children will learn about rocks and soils. They will explore how fossils are formed. In art and DT we will create various pieces linked to our topic including pyramid models and hieroglyphics.
