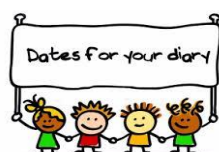
Finally, I would like to wish you all a fantastic half term. We look forward to seeing you after the holiday on Tuesday 4th June. Don't forget the first day back is sports day!
