Class 5 will consider the question 'What would Jesus do?'

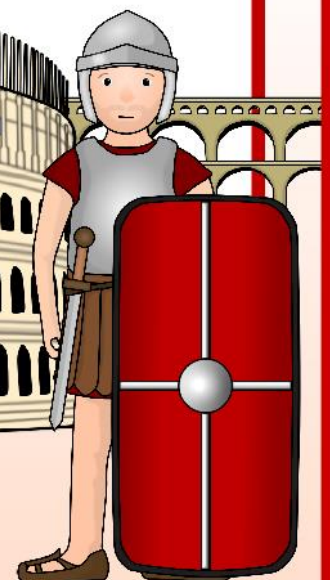
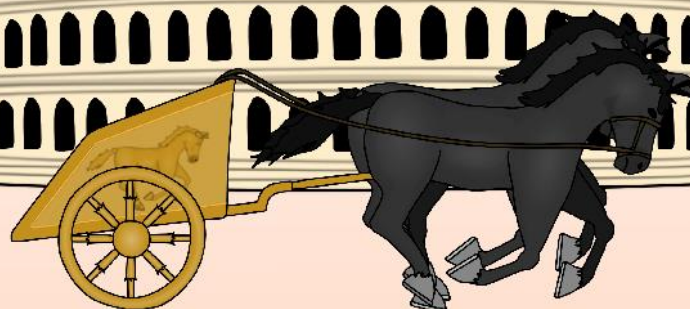


Our Spanish will focus on the weather and where people live.
