### Computing

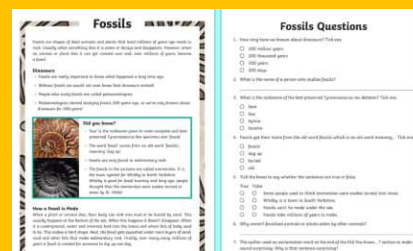
Go on To Code on Purple Mash. I have set Bubbles as a to do.
