Hello to my awesome new class!! (and parents/carers),

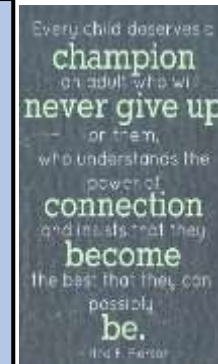
Here is a selection of activities for you to complete in readiness for your return to school. I would love for you to share some of this learning with me once complete.
