Admission is **FREE** for children up to 11 and only £3 for 12 to 16 year olds.




In addition to the 120 acres of parkland to explore (can you find the den, the willow igloo and the Green Man? Look out for the peacocks!), there's a range

AVAILABLE EVERY DAY

ADVENTURE BACKPACKS

Explore the great outdoors and learn about nature.

Each age-appropriate backpack contains a range of items and activities (e.g. bark rubbing kit, bird ID sheet). £3 rental charge + £10 refundable deposit.



MINIBEAST TRAIL

This **FREE**, fun trail is designed to help children explore nature & learn about the creatures they see along the way.

WOODLAND PLAYGROUND

Den building, balance beams, tree trunk bridges, log ladders and giant stepping stones - all created from the arboretum's own trees!
