What will we be learning during this term?

Our topic this term is **The Olympics**. These are some of the questions that we will study in **history** and **geography** this term.

When and where did the Olympic games begin?

What are the traditions of the Olympic games?

Where have the Olympics taken place?

What were the positive and negative aspects of holding the 2012 Olympic games

in London?

How will Rio be affected by the games?

What are the Paralympic games?

Art/DT:

We will be exploring past Olympic logos and designing our own. We will also be designing and making our own Olympic mascots.

Science

This term in science we will be focussing on plant life. We will look at the function of parts of flowering plants, requirements of growth, water transportation in plants, life cycles and seed disposal.

Excitingly, the children will have the opportunity to germinate both our seeds from space and some 'control' seeds. They will observe their germination, record the results and send the findings back to The Royal Horticultural Society.

For the first time we will also be studying evolution and inheritance which is a new topic in the primary curriculum.
