* Where are the rainforests in the world?

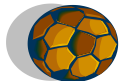
* What are habitats and who lives in them?

The children are continuing with E.R.I.C (Everybody Reading in Class) time. They are really enjoying bringing in their own books to read. I am more than happy for them to bring in books from home but please make sure that their name is inside the book.
