- In science, we will be investigating materials and making up simple experiments to test if they are waterproof. We must make sure our tests are fair!

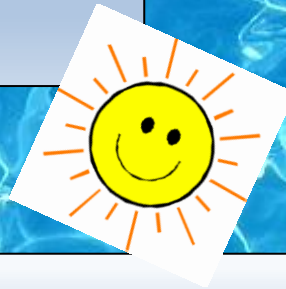


## P.E.
