- *What was life like for the Ancient Egyptians and how do we know?


We are currently planning a trip to DIG in York as well as visitors to come into school to truly bring this topic alive!

Our approach to teaching our topics means that children will develop skills across all curriculum areas.

In RE, children will continue to build on their knowledge of the Hindu faith in the first half term and move onto themes around the Easter story in the second half of the term.

In Maths and English, children will continue to follow the National Curriculum programmes of study for their year group.

From January, your child will bring home multiplication and division facts to learn each week. These will be tested in school to help improve speed and fluency.





Homework

Please listen to your child read for at least five minutes every day and record this in their planner. Reading aloud to an adult has huge benefits. For example, it opens discussion about the text and helps clarify vocabulary.


Maths homework will alternate between Mathematics tasks and more practical, investigative work from the Maths Jigsaw sheet.
