

Eco Club



In Eco Club, you can learn all about our natural environment and how to improve it and protect it. Eco Club is running through the summer term and there are still spaces available. This half term we have learnt about earthworms and made a wormery, collected sticks and bamboo to create mini bug hotels to encourage insects around the school, and made muddy wildflower seed bombs to take home. We have also rebuilt the large bug hotel habitat in the science garden, built a bird table in the science garden, and made mini bird feeders out of recycling! As part of the Eco Schools



programme, we are currently studying and improving the biodiversity of our school site and together we can work towards the goal of achieving Green Flag status. Anyone from KS2 can join and if you can't make Tuesdays but want to contribute, let one of our Eco Club members know your ideas and we can put them into action, or tell us what environmental stuff you're up to at home and we can celebrate it on our notice board.
