Headlice

We have been advised by more than one parent that there has been cases of head lice. Please can we ask all parents to check their children's hair and if necessary, treat the whole family accordingly. To stop the infestation from spreading any further, please can we also request that if your child's hair is long enough, it is tied back.

Medicines

Medicines should only be brought into school when **prescribed 4 times a day** or if doctor's instructions indicate a dosage at lunchtime. Where possible, we encourage you to ask doctors to prescribe medication in dose frequencies which can be taken outside school hours. It is the responsibility of parents to supply written information about the medication their child needs to take in school. Medication needs to be handed in at the office, where parents are required to complete details of the dosage and consent. Without written consent, we are unable to give out prescribed medicines during the school day. Unfortunately we are not able to give non-prescribed medication, over the counter medicines, to children.

Fruit/Healthy snack

Children in Classes 1 and 2 are provided free fruit daily. Children in Classes3, 4 and 5 may bring a piece of fruit or a healthy snack to eat during their morning break.

Lost Property

It has come to our attention that many children have brand new uniform and other items which are unnamed. Please help us to ensure children keep their belongings safe by clearly naming all their property.

Contact Details

It is really important for families to keep us up to date with their current contact details. Occasions can arise when we might need to contact you urgently during the school day regarding your child. It has come to our attention that we do not hold current details for some families. Please can you check these details are correct and inform Mrs Greening immediately if details need updating.

Sharing assemblies

Every Friday we celebrate the children's learning and achievements throughout the week. Classes take turn to share their learning each week. In addition to this, a child from each class is presented a certificate, chosen by their class teacher. We warmly invite all parents and grandparents to attend all of our Friday assemblies. They take place in our school hall and begin at 2:50pm.
