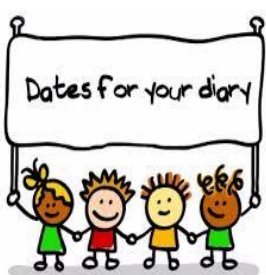

From the desk of *Santa Claus*

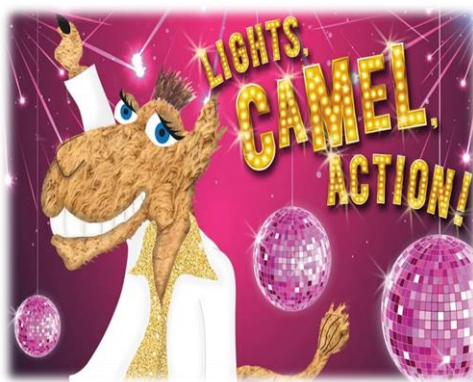
Dear Children,
