We wanted to update you all on the forthcoming plans to convert to an academy school and become part of the South York Multi-academy Trust. As many of you will already be aware, Mrs Savage, Headteacher of Fulford School and the current CEO of the South York MAT, announced her retirement from both roles just before Christmas.

Since our initial plans to become part of the South York MAT there have been some significant changes to the formation of the MAT, the drive from Government and proposed timescales for conversion. For instance, the local authority (City of York Council) have recently informed schools they are unable to convert any further schools, other than the limited number already scheduled, before 2020.

The Governors would like to reassure parents that we continue to monitor and discuss the development of the MAT, to ensure we achieve what will be the best for the school and children. With this in mind, we have invited Mrs Savage to our Full Governing Body on the 19th March. Polite Reminder – End of day procedures.

To ensure that all children are collected safely from school, may we remind parents that all children from EYFS-Y4 are to be collected by an agreed adult. School will regularly remind all children about keeping safe and following their agreed arrangements.

In Year 5 & 6 parents may feel that this is an appropriate age for children to walk part way or the whole way home. This is a parental decision and it is the duty of the parents to assess the risks associated with the school route and consider this in terms of their knowledge of their own child.

Written parental consent must be received if a child is to walk home alone or should any collection arrangements change. This can be given via a child's communication book or planner. In case of emergency, please do phone the school office.

It is the parent's responsibility to inform school of any changes to the end of day collection. School can not accept messages passed on from other parents.

The final payment for the Year 5/6 residential trip is due Wednesday 13th February. This can be made at any time via ParentPay. Please contact the office should you have any queries.


