I would like to thank Mrs Granger for organising the trips and say a huge thank you to all the parent helpers that have volunteered to help.

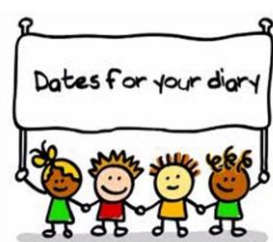
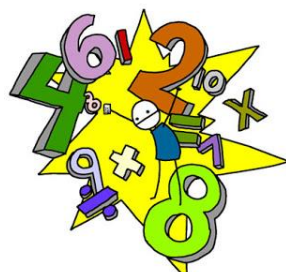

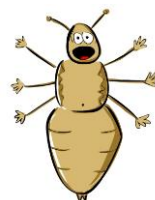
Eggstastic Fun!
