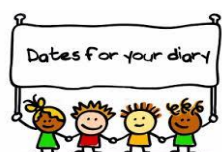

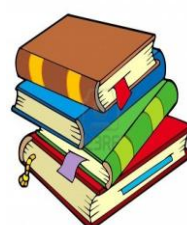


Elvington's Got Talent!
