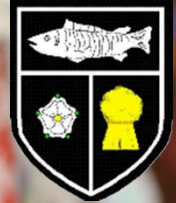

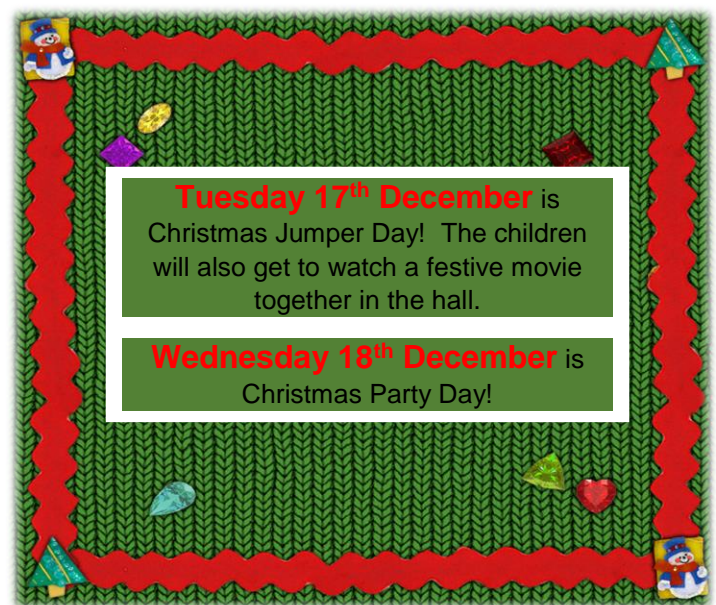
EYFS & KS1 Production – Lights, Camel, Action 2!
