

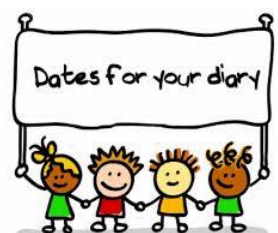

Run a Mile Club

The new twice weekly club, taken by Mr Buttery starts on **Tuesday 14th January**. It will start at 8.30 am prompt, and take place each Tuesday and Thursday, children will need to arrive in their PE kit.

The aim is to improve the physical, social and emotional wellbeing of our pupils, regardless of age and ability. This will be a social activity, wherein the children run or jog, at their own pace, in the fresh air with their friends. Children can occasionally walk to catch their breath, if necessary, however should aim to run or jog for the full 15 minutes.

Following 15 minutes of activity the children will get changed into their school uniform, prior to the start of lessons. The club will be open to pupils in all year groups.
