Key Stage 1 and E.Y.F.S visit to Temple Newsam Hall, Leeds

As part of our 'Kings, Queens and Castles' topic, Class 1 and Class 2 will be visiting Temple Newsam Hall, Leeds, on Thursday 30th January. The children will be taking part in two workshops; Kings and Queens and Princess and the Pea. The children will also have an opportunity to visit the park and house.

In order to make the most of our day, we will be leaving school at 9:15am. Please ensure your child is in school promptly so that we can register them and leave on time. We will return to school for 3:15pm.
