Write some instructions to go with your tasty treat. You could show your adult helper how we add actions to each step. Don't forget to add a title and numbers for each step.

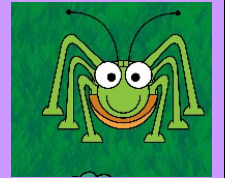
Challenge- Can you add a time connective to each step? E.g. First, next, then.

You will need your geography skills and the attached map.

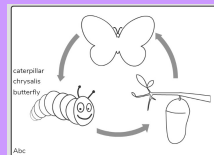
Name and locate the four countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom.
