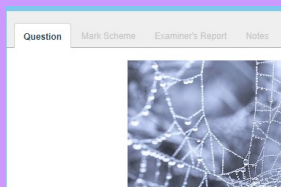
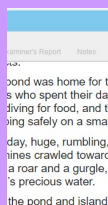

3. Share your finished creation on Twitter.

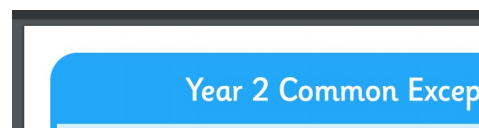

These could be:

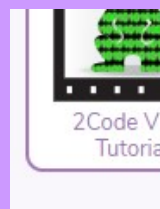
squats, skipping, bunny hops, running or any of your own made up moves.
