<p>1. Purple Mash- Sorting Sentences Log in to purple mash and you will find that I have set you a SPAG task. "Toy Shelf" You will need to remember the following:</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Question sentence ? *Exclamation sentence ! *Command sentence . *Statement sentence 	<p>2. Writing Different Sentences Once you have completed task 1, write 3 of each question sentences and 3 exclamation mark sentences.</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Question sentence- asks somebody something. Starts with what, where, when. *Exclamation sentence - is used when somebody is shocked or excited. Starts with how, what. <p>Challenge- Can you write a statement sentence?</p>	<p>Writing a Story Choose a traditional tale of your choice. E.g. Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Little Pigs or the Gingerbread Man. Read the story or watch a cartoon video online.</p>  <p>Day 1- Plan your story. You need a start, middle and end. Day 2/3- Write a part of your story each day. Challenge- Include the conjunctions- and, but, so, because.</p>

Practise your spellings with different coloured pencils.  <p>Challenge- Can you use the words in sentences?</p>	<p>Maths Mats</p>  <p>Attached is a pack of Y1 Maths Mat Sheets. There are 5 maths mats so you could complete one each day.</p> <p>If you would like an extra challenge, on page 6 there are some Maths problems to complete.</p> <p>Bonus challenge- Could you create your own Maths Mat?</p>	<p>Treasure Map Activity</p>  <p>Hide at least 4 pieces of treasure in your house or garden.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Draw a map of where the treasure is hidden. Ask somebody in your family to close their eyes or blindfold them. Using your map guide them to the treasure. Try and include the mathematical vocabulary: <p>Full turn, half turn, three quarter turn</p>
<p>Helping Hands</p>  <p>Help your parents out around the house. You could wash up, Hoover, help in the garden or clean the car. Write about how you have helped at home. What was the best part? Which bit did you find tricky?</p>	<p>Mystery Book Cover Challenge</p>  <p>Choose your favourite book and copy the front cover but do not include the title.
