<p><b>1. Purple Mash- Sorting Sentences</b> Log in to <b>purple mash</b> and you will find that I have set you some SPAG tasks. <b>"Toy Shelf" and "Little Red Meets the Wolf."</b></p> <p>You will need to remember the following:</p>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Question sentence ?</li> <li>*Exclamation sentence !</li> <li>*Command sentence .</li> <li>*Statement sentence</li> </ul>	<p><b>2. Writing Different Sentences</b> Once you have completed task 1, write 3 of each of the following sentences. You will have 12 sentences in total.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>*Question sentence ?</li> <li>*Exclamation sentence !</li> <li>*Command sentence .</li> <li>*Statement sentence</li> </ul> <p><b>Challenge-</b> Can you write a sentence with speech marks?</p> 	<p><b>Writing a Story</b> Choose a traditional tale of your choice. E.g. Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Little Pigs or the Gingerbread Man. Read the story or watch a carton video online.  Day 1- Plan your story. You need a start, middle and end. Day 2/3- Write a part of your story each day. <b>Challenge-</b> Include a range of conjunctions. You could also change a character.</p>
<p><b>Super Spellings - 10 Spellings a week</b> <b>Adding suffix full and less to make adjectives.</b> </p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Find the words in the word search and add on their correct suffix.</li> <li>Practise learning the spellings by using a different colour for each letter or writing them outside.</li> </ol> <p><b>Challenge-</b> Can you use the words in sentences?</p>	<p><b>Maths Mats</b></p>  <p>Attached is a pack of Y2 Maths Mat Sheets. There are <b>5 maths mats</b> so you could complete one each day.</p> <p>If you would like an extra challenge, on page 6 and 7 there are some Maths problems to complete.</p> <p><b>Bonus challenge-</b> Could you create your own Maths Mat?</p>	<p><b>Treasure Map Activity</b> Hide at <b>least 4 pieces of treasure</b> in your house or garden. </p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Draw a map of where the treasure is hidden.</li> <li>Ask somebody in your family to close their eyes or blindfold them.</li> <li>Using your map guide them to the treasure. Try and include the mathematical vocabulary:</li> </ol> <p>Full turn, half turn, three quarter turn</p>
<p><b>Helping Hands</b> Help your parents out around the house. You could wash up, Hoover, help in the garden or clean the car. Write about how you have helped at home. What was the best part? Which bit did you find tricky?</p> 	<p><b>Mystery Book Cover Challenge</b> </p> <p>Choose your favourite book and copy the front cover but do not include the title. You can use <b>paints, pencils, chalk outside or natural resources</b>. Post a picture on twitter or to your friend and see if somebody can guess the book. <b>Challenge-</b> Add a blurb for more clues.</p>	<p><b>Keeping Fit- Dancing</b> Watch a dance video online and join in with the moves. </p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Choose your favourite song.</li> <li>Plan some moves to go with the song.</li> <li>Record your dance.</li> <li>Share with a friend to try.</li> </ol>
