Change the settings to your current book band or the band above for a challenge.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Choose and read 3 different books over the week and complete the tasks to go with them.</li> <li>2. Complete the <b>attached reading comprehension</b> (Zoos).</li> </ol>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Creating 3D Shapes</u></b></p> <p>Write a list of the 3D shapes you can remember. Using materials that you have at home create at least 3 different 3D shapes. E.g. a sphere made from tin foil or a cuboid made from sticks and marshmallows.</p> <p style="color: blue;">Challenge- Write next to each shape their name and 3 properties: faces, edges and vertices.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Acrostic Poem</u></b></p> <p>An acrostic poem is where you have a word and each letter of each line spells out a word with a message.</p> <p style="color: orange;">Choose from the following words: Bear Class, Elvington School or your friends' name.</p> <p>Write the word down the left hand side of the page and create your poem. Add a colourful border and a picture. Then share with your school or friend.</p>

Design a poster to help you learn the 3 spellings of: <b>their, there, they're</b>.</li> <li>2. Write a sentence including the words <b>hear, here, pair and pear</b>. Watch Miss Palmer's Maths lesson video and join in. Using only items you have found create a portrait of yourself.
