

Geography Project

As you will know, many people have had to cancel or change their holiday plans this year and travel agents and shops have been closed. Your task is to choose one country in the world that you would like to visit and create a holiday brochure. You can present your work anyway you like: one way might be using PowerPoint or similar, or you could create a double page spread in your book. If you choose to do it in your book, use one page for planning and notes and a double page for the brochure itself. Plan in note form first and then create your brochure.

Day One- Your country-decision time!

Which country are you going to choose?

Draw a map outline of the country in your book.

Decide on a main city you would choose to visit, locate it on a map and plot it on your map in your book.

Write down why you have chosen that country and city and any things in particular you would like to find out.

What does the flag for your country look like? Add this to your page.

Day Two-fact file

Today you are going to research facts about the country you have chosen. You can research any of your ideas from yesterday or include some of my suggestions:

What continent is it in?

What language is spoken there? What is the approximate population?

What is the climate like?

What about the physical features-is it mountainous, volcanic etc..?

What countries are its neighbours?

Is it landlocked-if yes, by which countries? If no, which oceans/seas are there?

Day Three-tourist information

Today you will think about what things there are to do in the country and city you have chosen

For the country, you might like to include some of its main attractions: what are they and what makes them popular places to visit? Try and extend your sentences to be interesting and varied.

Ensure you are not just copying facts word for word-make it your own.

For your city-what does it have for tourists? What would you choose to see/visit? Why?

Day Four-Extra Facts

Today you will add final facts to your brochure. You might like to think about:

The food and drink from your country of choice.

Does your country have a traditional dish? If so, what is it?

What types of food and drink are popular in your country? Which would be your favourite?

Are there any sports that are particularly popular in your country? Are there any famous sportsmen/women from your country?

Are there any famous people from your country? Are they national or internationally famous? Who are they and what are they famous for?

Day Five-Brochure

Add as much interesting information to your brochure as you can from the notes you have made.

Think about your layout-Do you want different boxes for different information? Are you going to use capital letters or bubble writing etc... for effect? Don't forget to add some art and colour! If you choose to complete the work on a computer you could vary your background/font etc... and add in some pictures/photos. Don't forget I'd love you to share your work @class5elves Mrs Haffey
