
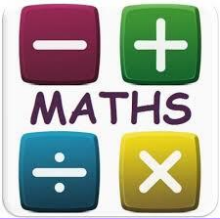


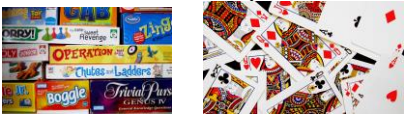


Year 4 Homework Autumn Term (1st Half)
