Who will be joining us?



- Reading- Please continue to read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners.
- Phonics- A phonics task will continue to be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class. An additional sheet will also be provided for Year 1 children, with a list of spellings linking to the phonics work. Each Friday the children will have a mini spelling quiz in class. Phonics and spelling homework will be given every Friday and should be returned by the following Thursday.
- Homework book- This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "Toy Story" covering a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the next Thursday to be marked. Those activities highlighted in <u>purple</u> are compulsory and have a hand in date.
- Times Table Rockstars or Numbots- Please encourage your child to continue to go on Numbots in EYFS and both Times table Rockstars and Numbots in Year 1. The children can refer to their planner to find their password.
- Super Start and Fabulous finish To launch the new topic of toys the children will write a letter inviting their favourite toy to join them for popcorn and a movie. We will be watching a family favourite, 'Toy Story.' Please can your child bring their favourite toy to join them on Friday 6th November 2020.
