# Mr Buttery's Update

## COVID-19

If your child has a positive COVID-19 diagnosis, or is having a test/required to self-isolate, please inform the school using the following email address, as soon as you find out: <a href="head@elvingtonprimary.org.uk">head@elvingtonprimary.org.uk</a>. The aforementioned email address will be checked regularly - seven days a week and over holidays. The school will always inform you as soon as we can if there has been a confirmed case within your child's bubble and if your son or daughter needs to isolate. However, we will never name the child/staff member who has tested positive.

We must all continue to be vigilant of COVID-19 symptoms: a new continuous cough, a high temperature or the loss of taste or smell. # **Christmas Arrangements**

The necessary protective measures for schools mean that we are unable to hold our usual range of events, services and celebrations. We are determined, however, to celebrate Christmas and to enjoy events that comply with COVID-19 guidance for schools.

**Animated Objects Theatre Company -** On Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> December the children will enjoy separate performances in their class bubbles. Precautions are in place to ensure that we will enjoy the Christmas performances, in the knowledge that Animated Objects will be delivering the activity safely for all involved.

**Christmas Lunch** - On Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> December our kitchen team will be cooking a Christmas lunch for the children to enjoy in class bubbles. If you would like your child to have a Christmas Lunch please book this on Parentpay, in the usual way, by 8<sup>th</sup> December. If you have any problems with booking, please contact Mrs Greening. This will also be Christmas Jumper Day, children are invited to wear a Christmas Jumper or a bright coloured/sparkly top. Apart from the aforementioned, children should wear normal school uniform. **Christmas Parties** - On Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> December (Classes 3, 4 & 5) and Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> December (Classes 1 & 2), the children are invited to come to school wearing their party clothes. They will have party games and fun activities within their class bubbles.

Christmas Cards - With COVID-19 restrictions in place, we will need to distribute Christmas Cards a little differently this year. I would like to request that from Monday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2020, children bring their Christmas Cards into school on the Monday and Tuesday of that week e.g. Monday 30<sup>th</sup> November, Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> December, Monday 7<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> December etc. The last day to bring cards into school will be Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> December; cards will then be distributed weekly on a Friday. Could you please ensure that envelopes clearly show the recipient's full name and class; this will help us to deliver cards efficiently.
