COVID-19

As parents and carers are aware, from Monday 9th November 2020, we requested that you wear a face covering when dropping children off and then collecting them at the end of the day. If your child has a positive COVID-19 diagnosis, or is having a test/required to self-isolate, please inform the school using the following email address, as soon as you find out: head@elvingtonprimary.org.uk. The aforementioned email address will be checked regularly - seven days a week and over holidays. The school will always inform you as soon as we can if there has been a confirmed case within your child's bubble and if your son or daughter needs to isolate. However, we will never name the child/staff member who has tested positive.

We must all continue to be vigilant of COVID-19 symptoms; a new continuous cough, a high temperature or the loss of taste or smell. If a child, or any member of their household, has any of these symptoms, however mild, they must not come to school and should seek a test as soon as possible by calling 119 or visiting: www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/testing-and-tracing/get-a-test-to-check-if-you-have-coronavirus/.

Christmas Cards

With COVID-19 restrictions in place, we will need to distribute Christmas Cards a little differently this year. I would like to request that from Monday 30th November 2020, children bring their Christmas Cards into school on the Monday and Tuesday of that week e.g. Monday 30th November, Tuesday 1st December, Monday 7th, Tuesday 8th December etc. The last day to bring cards into school will be Tuesday 15th December; cards will then be distributed weekly on a Friday.

Could you please ensure that envelopes clearly show the recipient's full name and class; this will help us to deliver cards efficiently.
