Mr. Buttery's Update

Running Track

As I am sure your children will have informed you, our artificial grass (all-weather) running circuit is now fully operational.

The track facilitates improved physical, social and emotional wellbeing – regardless of age or ability. Using the track is an enjoyable activity, wherein the children run or jog (at their own pace) in the fresh air with their friends. Children can occasionally walk to catch their breath, if necessary, however the aim is for them to run or jog for ten laps (this equates to 1 mile).







Summer Term

There has been little in the way of information from the Department for Education (DfE) about the coming months. We have been advised by the local authority, for the time being, not to book any educational visits and to only make very tentative plans for late June and July. Although the Government's plan is to lift restrictions on 21st June, this is only an indicative date and so much has to fall into place before that milestone is reached. After the Easter break we hope to have more details; I will then share with you our own provisional plan for the later stages of the Summer Term.



School Based Extra-Curricular Activities

Please remember there will be no extra-curricular activities during the remainder of the Spring Term. This is in order to avoid pupils mixing beyond their class bubble. As we undertake further risk assessment exercises (during the first half of the Summer Term) we will keep you updated as to when clubs can safely resume.

Healthy Snacks

The school operates a healthy snacks policy whereby children choosing to bring a snack for break time should choose fresh fruit or vegetables. Children have been bringing Bear Pure Fruit Yo Yos into school, these are permitted. However, an increasing number of children are bringing predominantly chocolate based snacks into school. I would like to politely request that this stops.

The Foundation and KS1 children receive fruit and vegetables, offered under the Government initiative to provide all infants with free fruit and vegetables during the day.

COVID-19

If your child has a positive COVID-19 diagnosis, or is having a test/required to self-isolate, please inform the school using the following email address, as soon as you find out: <u>head@elvingtonprimary.org.uk</u>. The aforementioned email address will be checked regularly - seven days a week and over holidays. The school will always inform you as soon as we can if there has been a confirmed case within your child's bubble and if your son or daughter needs to isolate. However, we will never name the child/staff member who has tested positive.

We must all continue to be vigilant of COVID-19 symptoms: a new continuous cough, a high temperature or the loss of taste or smell. If a child, or any member of their household, has any of these symptoms, however mild, they must not come to school and should seek a test as soon as possible by calling 119 or visiting: www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid19/testing-and-tracing/get-a-test-to-check-if-you-have-coronavirus/.
