How can you help at home?



- Reading- Please continue to read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners. All EYFS children will receive a new book on a Monday and then on a Thursday. Book bags can now come into school daily and the children will return them home at the end of the school day. Children in Year 1 can continue to change their books as they are finished.
- Phonics- A phonics task will continue to be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class. An additional sheet will also be provided for Year 1 children, with a list of spellings linked to the phonics work. Each Friday the children will continue to have a mini spelling quiz in class. Phonics and spelling homework will be given every Friday and should be returned by the following Thursday.
- Homework book— This half term there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "A Bucket Full of Roars" covering a range of curriculum areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the next Thursday to be marked. Those activities highlighted in purple are compulsory and have a hand in date.
- Times Table Rockstars and Numbots— Please encourage your child to continue to go on Numbots in EYFS and both Times Table Rockstars and Numbots in Year
 The children can refer to their planner to find their password.
- <u>Super Start and Fabulous finish</u> To launch the new topic of 'A Bucket Full of Roars' we will all go on a Mini Beast Adventure! We will all explode with excitement as we end our topic and enter the land of the dinosaurs, seeing volcanoes erupting!




