#### Mr. Buttery's Update


Unfortunately, COVID-19 infection levels continue to rise across North Yorkshire and particularly in the City of York area. A number of local schools currently have bubbles isolating. We continue to need your help to ensure that school remains as COVID-19 secure as possible.

As the parents/carers of our Year 6 children know, unfortunately their child's transition visit to secondary school has been cancelled this academic year. As a result, it will not be possible for our in school transition event to take place, as this would involve crossing multiple bubbles. We have planned transition style activities to replicate the aforementioned event in September. These will be bespoke to each class and will give the children the opportunity to acquaint themselves with their new teacher/teachers, support staff and classroom environment.

Could I please remind parents and carers that once you have dropped your child/ren off in the morning, you should not retrace your steps back down the side of Elvington Lane where the children and parents/carers are queuing. Please avoid gathering in this area once your child is dropped off/collected and use the semi-permanent markings to support social distancing.

Please ensure that you continue to adhere strictly to the time slots allocated for drop off and collection times. Older siblings can continue to be dropped off at an earlier time, as long as this fits within the younger child's time slot. These older children will then wait in our covered outdoor waiting area, until their bubble enters the building. This is in order to ensure that bubbles do not mix during these periods.

#### COVID-19

If your child has a positive COVID-19 diagnosis, or is having a test/required to self-isolate, please inform the school using the following email address, as soon as you find out: <a href="head@elvingtonprimary.org.uk">head@elvingtonprimary.org.uk</a>. The aforementioned email address will be checked regularly - seven days a week and over holidays. The school will always inform you as soon as we can if there has been a confirmed case within your child's bubble and if your son or daughter needs to isolate. However, we will never name the child/staff member who has tested positive.

We must all continue to be vigilant of COVID-19 symptoms: a new continuous cough, a high temperature or the loss of taste or smell.
