



<u>Welcome to Class 1 Year 1 Hedgehogs!</u>

How can you help at home?



- * <u>Reading-</u> Please read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners.
- Phonics- A phonics task will be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class. An additional sheet will also be provided for Year 1 children, with a list of spellings linking to the phonics work. Each Friday the children will have a mini spelling quiz in class. Phonics and spelling homework will be given every Friday and should be returned the following Thursday.
- Homework book- Your child will be provided with a "Homework Book". This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "Paddington Bear" covering a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the next Thursday to be marked. Compulsory activities will be highlighted in purple and should be handed in by the specified date.
- Times Table Rockstars, My Maths or Numbots- Please encourage your child to access Timestable Rockstars, My Maths and Numbots. The children can refer to their planner to find their password.
