

How can you help at home?

- * <u>Reading-</u> Please continue to read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners.
- Phonics- A phonics task will be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class. An additional sheet will also be provided, with a list of spellings linking to the phonics work to learn at home ready for a mini quiz in class. Year 1 will be given 4 spellings and Year 2 will be given 6 spellings. Phonics and spelling homework will be given every Friday and should be returned a week later, on the Friday.
- Times Table Rockstars + Numbots- Please continue to encourage your child to go on these websites at home.
- Homework book- Your child will be provided with a "Homework Book". This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "It's all in a picture" covering a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the next Friday to be marked.

<u>Science</u> Animals including humans
