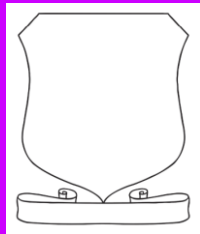


Class 4 Homework Spring Term (1st half) Purple task = to be completed. White task = optional.
