

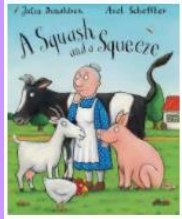
Class 1 EYFS Homework Spring Term (1st half)

National Trust Activity



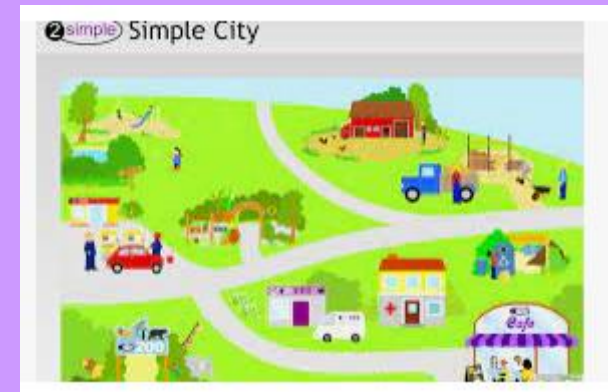
Activity No 6 Go Welly Wandering
