Or (if you're a time expert) to the nearest minute?</p>	<p><u>Science</u></p> <p>Grow a fruit or vegetable plant from a seed. Keep a diary of your seed's progress.</p> <p>Challenge: When your seed starts to grow, measure it each week to see how much it has grown.</p> 	<p><u>Who/what makes me happy?</u></p> <p>This term, we will be talking about feelings and emotions. Draw a picture of someone or something that makes you happy.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write some sentences about your picture?</p> <p>To be completed by 21st January</p>

Try to use every writing skill you have learnt at school so far.</p> <p>Remember capital letters, full stops, spaces between words and adjectives.
