Who will be joining us?



How can you help at home?

Phonics - A phonics task will be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class. Phonics homework and the flashcard pack will be given out each Friday and should be returned the following Thursday.

Homework book- Your child will be provided with a "Homework Book". This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to the topic "Superheroes" covering a range of curricular areas. Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the following Thursday to be marked. Compulsory activities are highlighted in purple and should be handed in on the date specified.
