 <p><b>Maths Activities-</b></p> <p>Smartie fractions. Practise finding half or quarter of amounts using smarties (or another sweet of your choice) What is half of 8? What is quarter of 8? What is half of 12? What is quarter of 12? What is two quarters of 12? What is three quarters of 12? Write down some smartie fraction facts.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> What is a third of 9? What is two thirds of 9?</p> <p><b>To be completed after Friday 13<sup>th</sup> May</b></p>	<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Research the weather in August in different parts of the world. What are the temperatures like in different countries?</p>  	<p><b>Geography</b></p> <p>Keep a weather diary for a week. What weather types have you recorded?</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> Make a rain gauge and measure how much rain falls over a two or three week period.</p>

Talk about how they have adapted to the places that they live in?</p>	<p><b>Writing</b></p> <p>Make a list of items that an explorer would need to take with them if they were going somewhere very cold (eg the North Pole.)</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> write another list to show what they would need if they were going somewhere very warm (eg Africa)</p> 
<p><b>Explore on wheels.</b></p>  <p>Why not get out and explore your surroundings on wheels? There are lots of lovely cycle tracks nearby.
