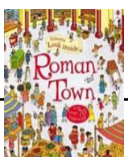


## How can you help at home?

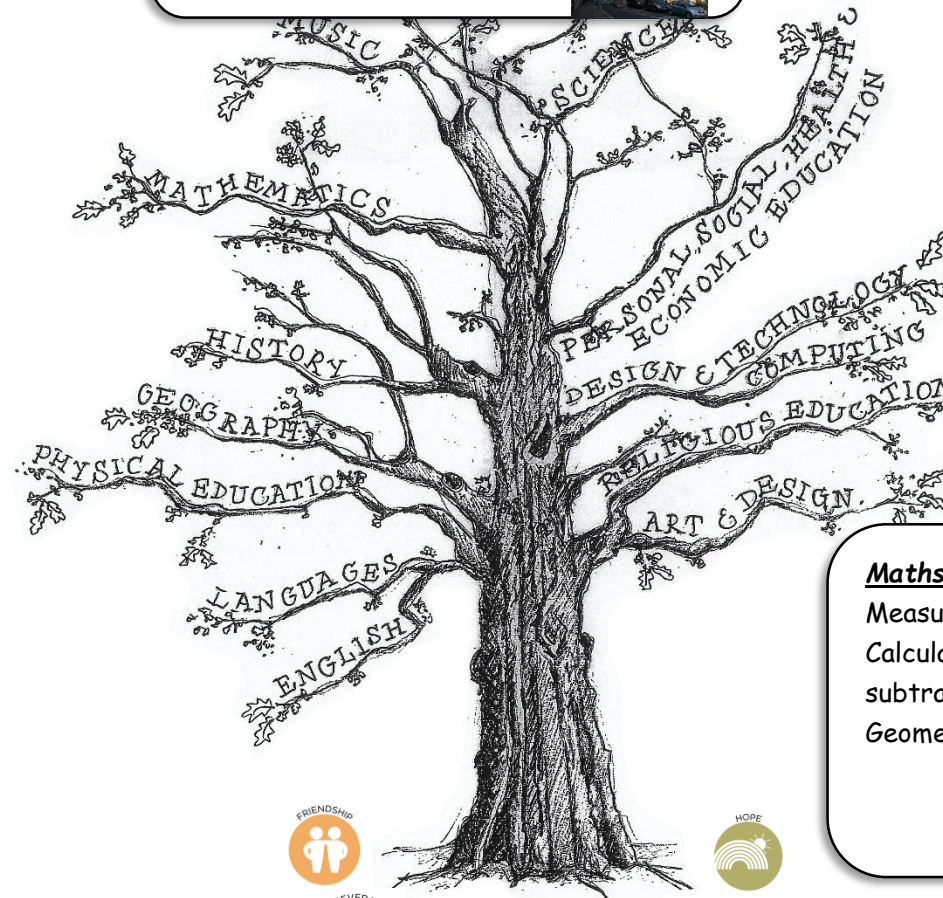
