Electricity is our topic this half term. Firstly, we will identify common appliances that run on electricity. We will construct a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers. - 3, Letter



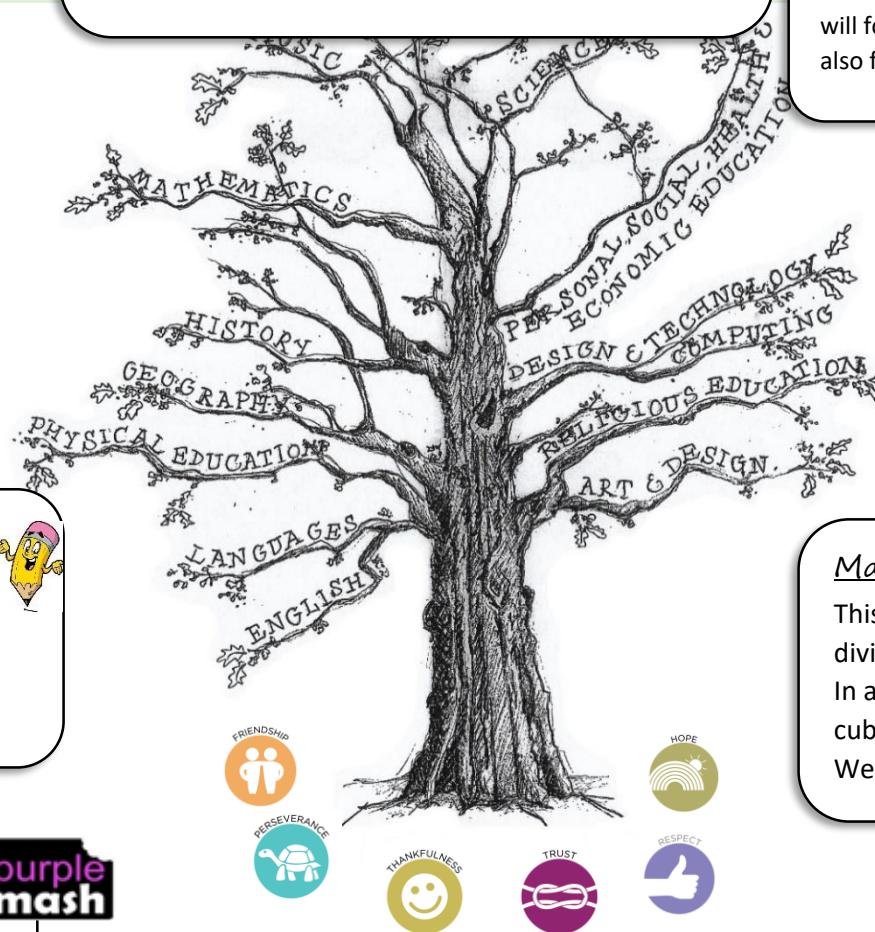
Computing

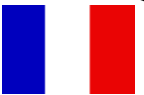
