*Miss Croasdale and Mrs Leach will continue to support Class 2 this half term. Mrs Grayson will support Class 2 on a Thursday afternoon.


* Mrs Marjoram and Mr Buttery will continue to teach Class 2 on a Monday and Wednesday afternoon.




