How can you help at home?

- ❖ **Reading-** Please read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day. After reading, please record this in your child's planner. This could just be a well done and the page number.
- ❖ **Phonics-** A phonics task will be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class or a news book activity. Also, an additional list will be provided for Year 1 children, with a list of 6 spellings linking to the phonics work. Each Friday the children will have a mini spelling quiz in class. Phonics and spelling homework will be given every Friday and should be returned the following Thursday.
- ❖ **Homework books-** This half term, there will be a grid of tasks linking to our topic theme "Starry Night". Each week, your child should try to do one task from the grid and return it to school by the following Thursday to be marked. **Compulsory activities are highlighted in purple and should be handed in on the date specified.**
- ❖ **Times Table Rockstars or Numbots-** Please encourage your child to continue to go on Numbots in EYFS and use Timestable Rockstars in Year 1. The children can refer to their planner to find their password.

- Look at the famous artist Vincent Van Gogh and his piece Starry Night.



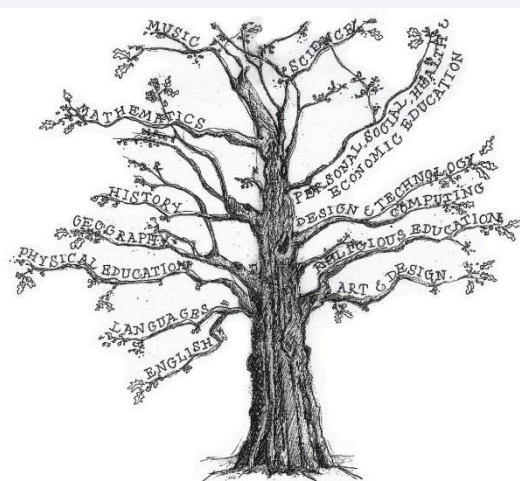
