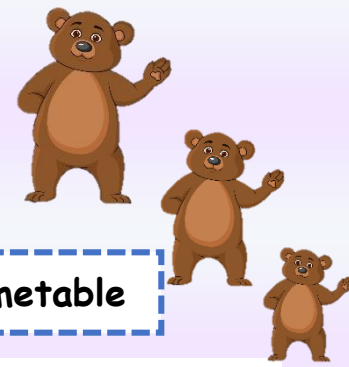

How can you help at home?

- ❖ **Reading-** Please continue to read and practise phonic flash cards with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners. **Year 2- For this half term, Year 2 children will be given a reading comprehension to complete instead of phonics and spellings.** Please support your child reading the text and answering the questions. We will then go through the answers in school on a Friday morning.
- ❖ **Phonics-** A phonics task and weekly spellings will continue to be given for **Year 1** each Friday linking to what we have been learning in class. **Year 1 spellings will increase this half term from 4 spellings to 6.**
- ❖ **Times Table Rockstars + Numbots-** Please continue to encourage your child to go on the following websites at home.
- ❖ **Homework book-** Your child will be provided with a new topic homework sheet linking to our new topic "Starry Night". Please help your child complete the purple tasks and if you would like to, complete some of the optional white tasks. Please return the homework book to school each Friday to be marked.

- *Looking at the famous artist Vincent Van Gogh and his famous piece- Starry Night.

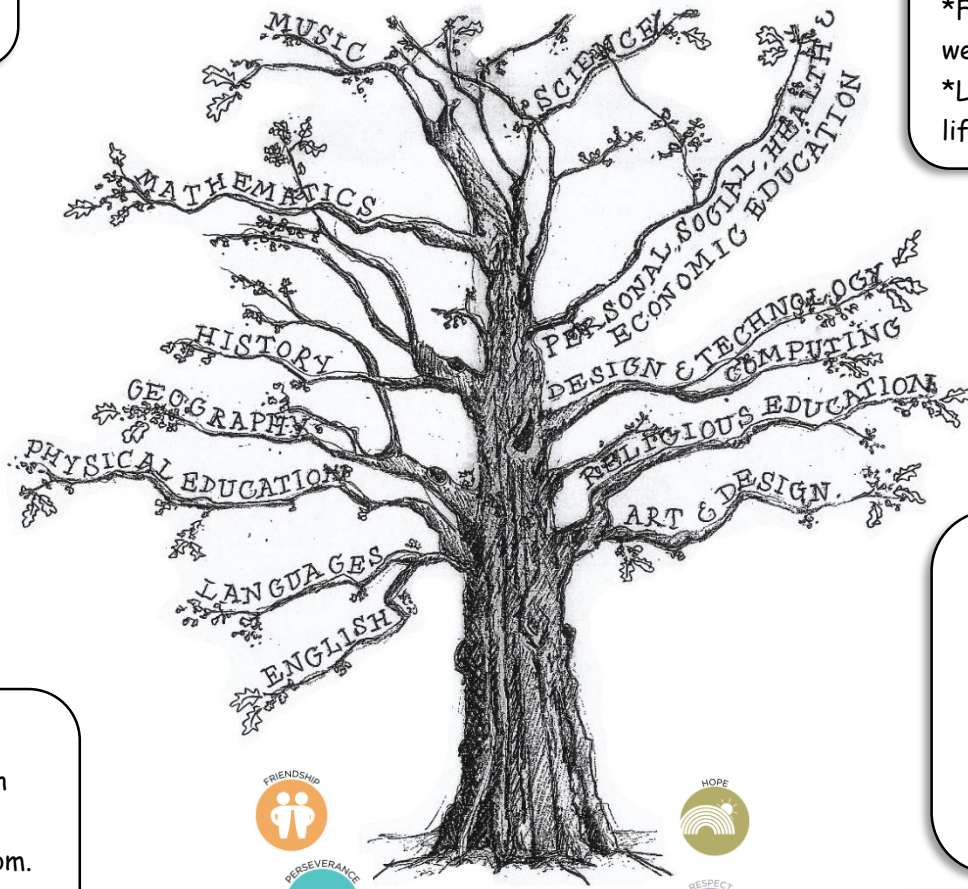
