

Working scientifically

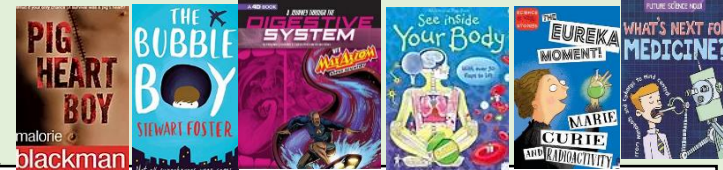
Properties and Changes of Materials

Key question: **For Christians, when Jesus left, what was the impact of Pentecost?**



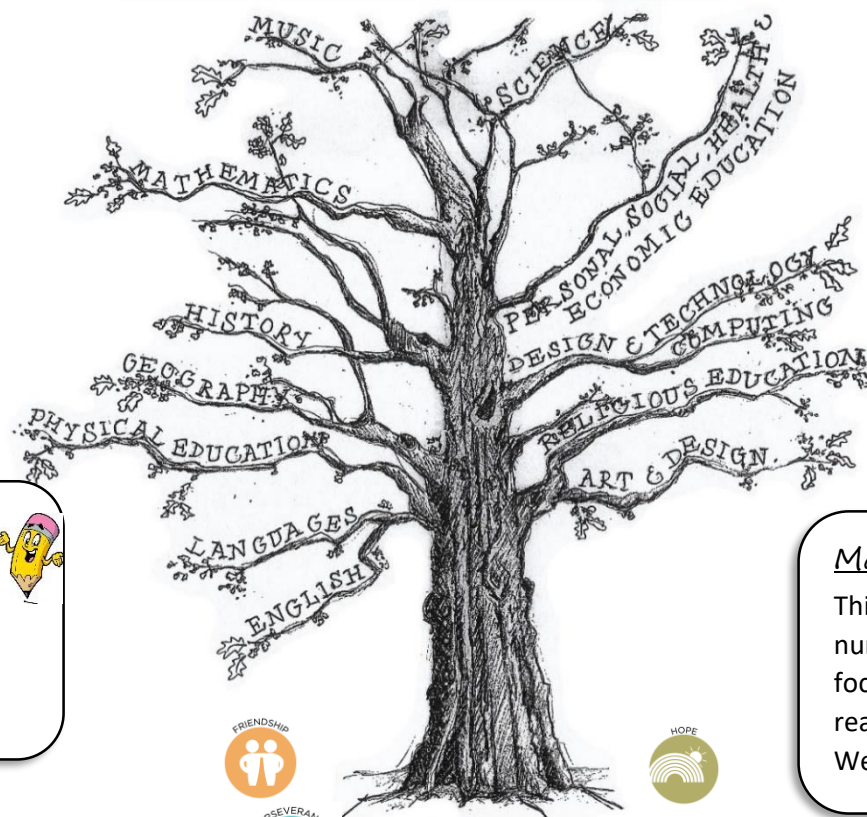
Art & Design Technology:

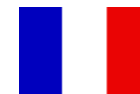


French
