## **Whole School Trip to Bridlington Beach – Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> July**

In order to make the most of the day, we will be leaving school by 9:10am. Please ensure your child is in school promptly so that we can register them and leave on time. We will return to school for 3:15pm.

On the day, your child will need to have an easy to carry back pack and a water bottle. They may bring along beach toys such as buckets, spades or balls etc. A packed lunch is provided by school if your child is in Class 1 or 2. If your child would prefer a packed lunch from home, please let Mrs. Greening know. KS2 children will need a packed lunch. If they would like to order one from school, please let Mrs. Greening know.

We hope the weather will be kind to us, however, please ensure your child is dressed in their school uniform and prepared for every eventuality. They will need to have sun cream and a hat or warm, waterproof clothes depending on the weather. Please remember to apply your child's sun cream before they leave home.

We are kindly asking for a voluntary contribution of £10.00 per child to cover the cost of transport. Thank you to the PTA who have kindly subsidised the cost of the ice creams for each child. There is no obligation to contribute and no child will be omitted from the visit because they do not pay or do not pay in full. However, the visit cannot go ahead if the school does not receive sufficient parental contributions.
