How can you help at home?

- * Reading- Please continue to read with your child for at least 5 minutes every day and record this in their planners. Your child will bring home a Bug Club Book daily, which they can change in school when needed. Every Thursday, your child will bring home their Little Wandle book, which they will have looked at over 3 reads in school. Please share this book together at home and return this to school the following Monday. Your child will also have the chance to visit the Library once every 2 weeks.
- ❖ Phonics- A phonics task will be given once a week linking to the sounds/words we are focusing on in class. An additional sheet▲ will also be provided, with a list of spellings linking to the phonics work to learn at home ready for a mini guiz in class. Phonics and spelling homework will be given every Friday and should be returned a week later.
